CATALPA COMMEMORATION, Easter Monday 17th April, 11 am

Annual commemoration of the escape of six Fenian convicts on 17-18 April, 1876. The Catalpa memorial depicts 6 wild geese in flight commissioned by Rockingham Council and created by Charles and Joan Walsh-Smith. It was unveiled in September 2005.

Free event presented by AIHA with a program of music, song, poetry, historic and reflective presentations commemorating the escape on this exact date 141 years ago.

Special guests include His Worship Mayor Barry Sammels, Deputy Mayor Deb Hamblin with Brendan Woods, Luke McRae, Lachlan Kelly, musicians Ormonde Og Waters and Fred Rae and prominent members of the Australian-Irish community. Free event. Flier attached
